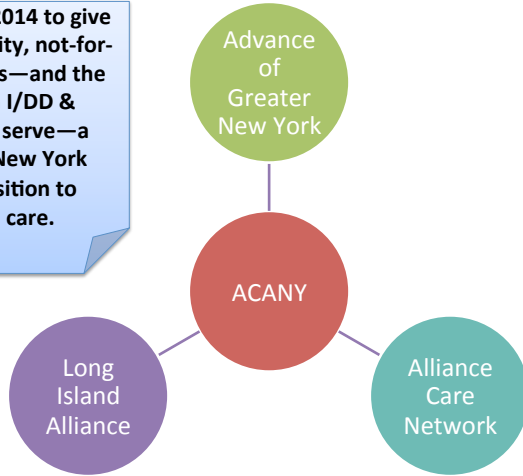

ACANY FORMED BY THREE PROVIDER GROUPS SERVING PEOPLE WITH I/DD



Established in 2014 to give 100+ high-quality, not-for-profit providers—and the people with I/DD & families they serve—a voice in the New York State’s transition to managed care.



ACANY = Advance Care Alliance of NY
I/DD = Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities

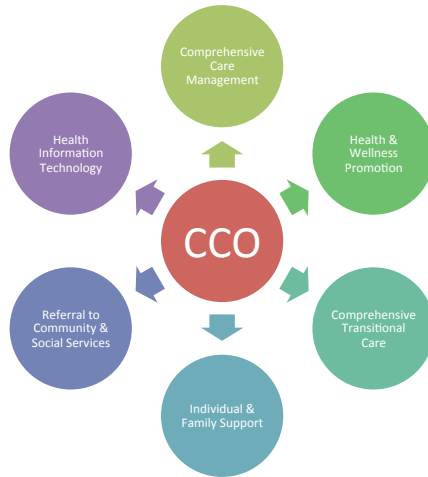
Three Factors Driving the Transition

1115 Waiver	Health Homes	Conflict Free Care Management
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1915(c) → 1115 enables eventual transition to managed care • 1115 Waiver provides more flexibility to reimburse new types of (previously excluded) services, e.g. START program 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enabled by the <i>Affordable Care Act of 2010</i> to promote holistic, person-centered care management within Medicaid programs • Enhanced funding from Federal Government 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CMS rule that requires Care Management to be performed independently of OPWDD waiver program services • NY is moving towards compliance with Federal mandate

START = Systemic, Therapeutic, Assessment, Resources & Treatment
CMS = Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services



CCOs: SPECIALIZED HEALTH HOMES DESIGNED FOR PEOPLE WITH I/DD



CCO = Care Coordination Organization
 I/DD = Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities



BEING DEVELOPED FROM & BY EXISTING MSC SERVICE PROVIDERS



Health Home
Care
Management

- Designed as “MSC Plus”
- More comprehensive coordination and support (including with medical and mental health providers)

Basic HCBS
Plan Support

- Less intense level of support with 4 contacts (maximum) per year
- Provides limited, essential functions to ensure continued access to HCBS waiver

MSC = Medicaid Service Coordination
 HCBS = Home & Community-Based Services

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HOW WILL THIS TRANSITION HELP ME OR MY LOVED ONE?


Centralizing All the Expertise and Resources of Affiliated Agencies

IRA Resident	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Care Manager coordinates with residential staff, offering an extra layer of support and resources when and if needed • Assistance with transition to other residential settings of a person's choosing
Community Resident	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Care Manager promotes health and wellness through better access to preventative care and medical specialists if needed • Connection with both Medicaid- and Non Medicaid-funded community resources of a person's choosing
Child	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Care Manager assists parents with information and support regarding care and services • Proactive planning and specialized expertise in the school-to-adult services transition

IRA = Individualized Residential Alternative

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TIMELINE FOR CCO ENROLLMENT



3/28/18

- OPWDD to send informational packets with personalized letters to all affiliated MSC agencies

4/1/18

- MSC agencies begin education & outreach to distribute enrollment letters, information-sharing consent forms, and other resources


6/1/18

- Supported decision-making for individuals who cannot consent or do not have someone to consent on their behalf


7/1/18

- CCOs begin operations

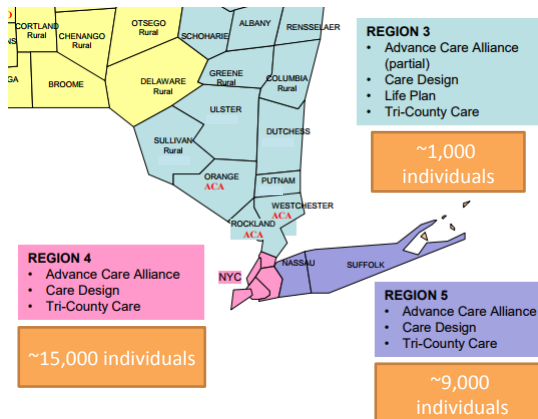

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 MSC = Medicaid Service Coordination/Coordinator



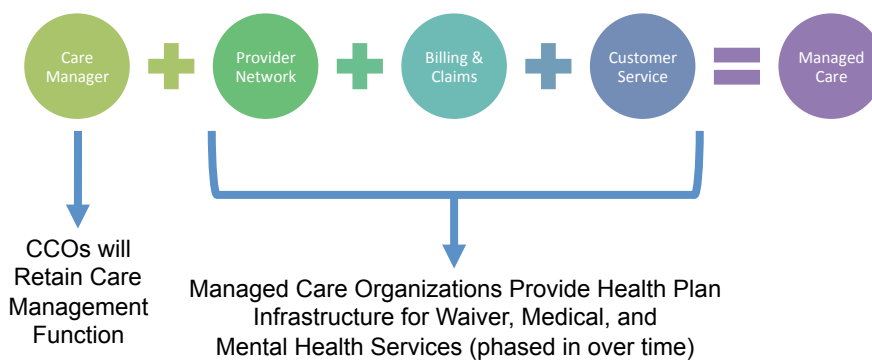
OVERALL TIMELINE FOR NY'S IMPLEMENTATION OF MANAGED CARE

SPECIALIZED MANAGED CARE FOR PEOPLE WITH I/DD



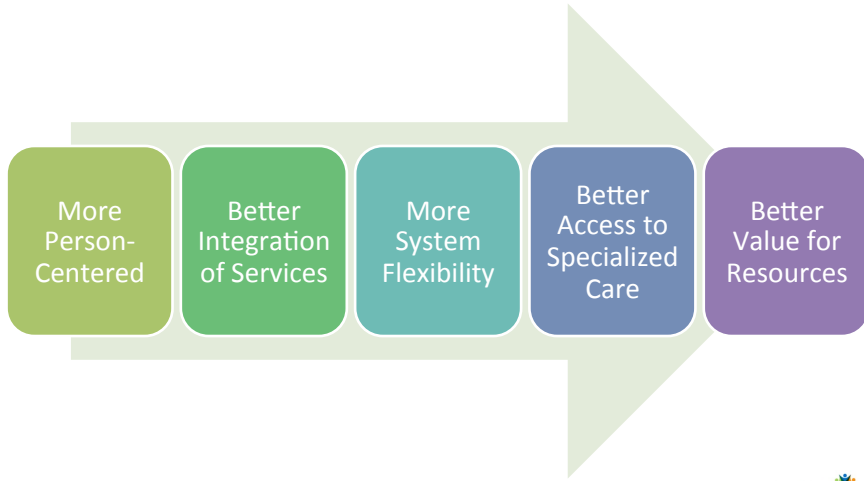
